# Carton Contents

# Open The Carton

The bike will arrive flat packed and protected in its box. Cut the protective nylon straps, tape and open the top of the Crooze carton, making sure the red arrows are facing the correct way up. Remove all loose contents including the styrofoam packaging, except the bicycle frame. Remove the packaging from the front fender and front wheel so its ready to fit. Lift out the bicycle frame taking care when placing it on the ground as you will be resting the bicycle on its front forks see fig.1.

Make sure all of the contents listed above are present and place them away from your bicycle frame while you complete the assembly.





## *Charge The Battery*

Place the charger connector into the battery port ensuring the 3 prongs are aligned, plug the power cord into your wall power outlet. Turn on the switch and a red light will show the battery is charging, green light if the battery is fully charged.



# Handlebar

Remove the rubber protective cap and mount the handlebar stem into the frame of the bicycle. Tighten the screw with the allen key (see fig.2) on top of the stem underneath the rubber protective cap to secure the handlebars in place. Make sure the handlebars are aligned with the front wheel before tightening. Check the stem is not above the maximum height indicator. You can adjust the stem height to suit.



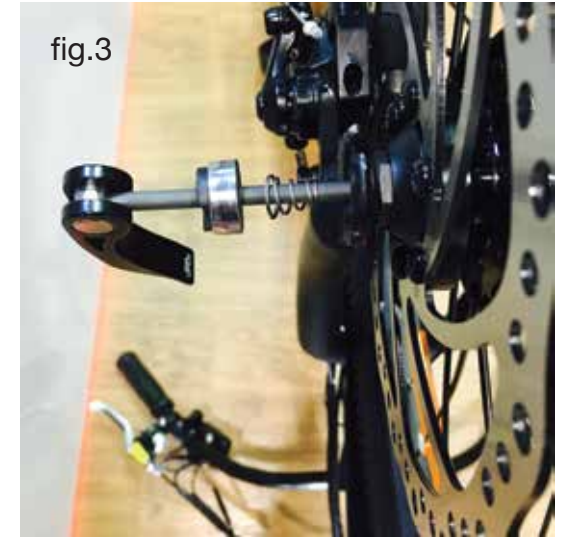
# Front Fender & Light

Mount the front fender (mudguard) prior to fitting the front wheel, use an allen key and spanner for side screws. Attach the front light at this time, ensure the loose plug is connected to the power.



# Front Wheel

Fit the front wheel onto the forks and tighten with the quick release bolt. Take care that the springs are positioned correctly see fig.3



# Seat

Insert the seat post into the frame and lock the quick release at the correct height, make sure the seat is in line with the bicycle frame and not twisting side to side see fig.4



# Pedals

Put the pedals on by screwing the Right pedal clockwise and Left anti-clockwise with your fingertips, the pedals are marked with "R" for right and "L" for left specific see fig.5

# Safety Checks

Pump up your tyres to the recommended PSI, you can confirm the correct PSI on the side of the tyre.

Take your ebike for spin without the power firstly to check the brakes, gears and to ensure no other loose parts or screws. Ride on a path away from traffic, pedestrians and other obstacles until you become familiar with the controls, features and performance of your new Crooze Electric Bicycle. Don't forget your helmet!

Please always refer to the owners manual inside the carton for full operational instructions of your electric bicycle prior to riding.
